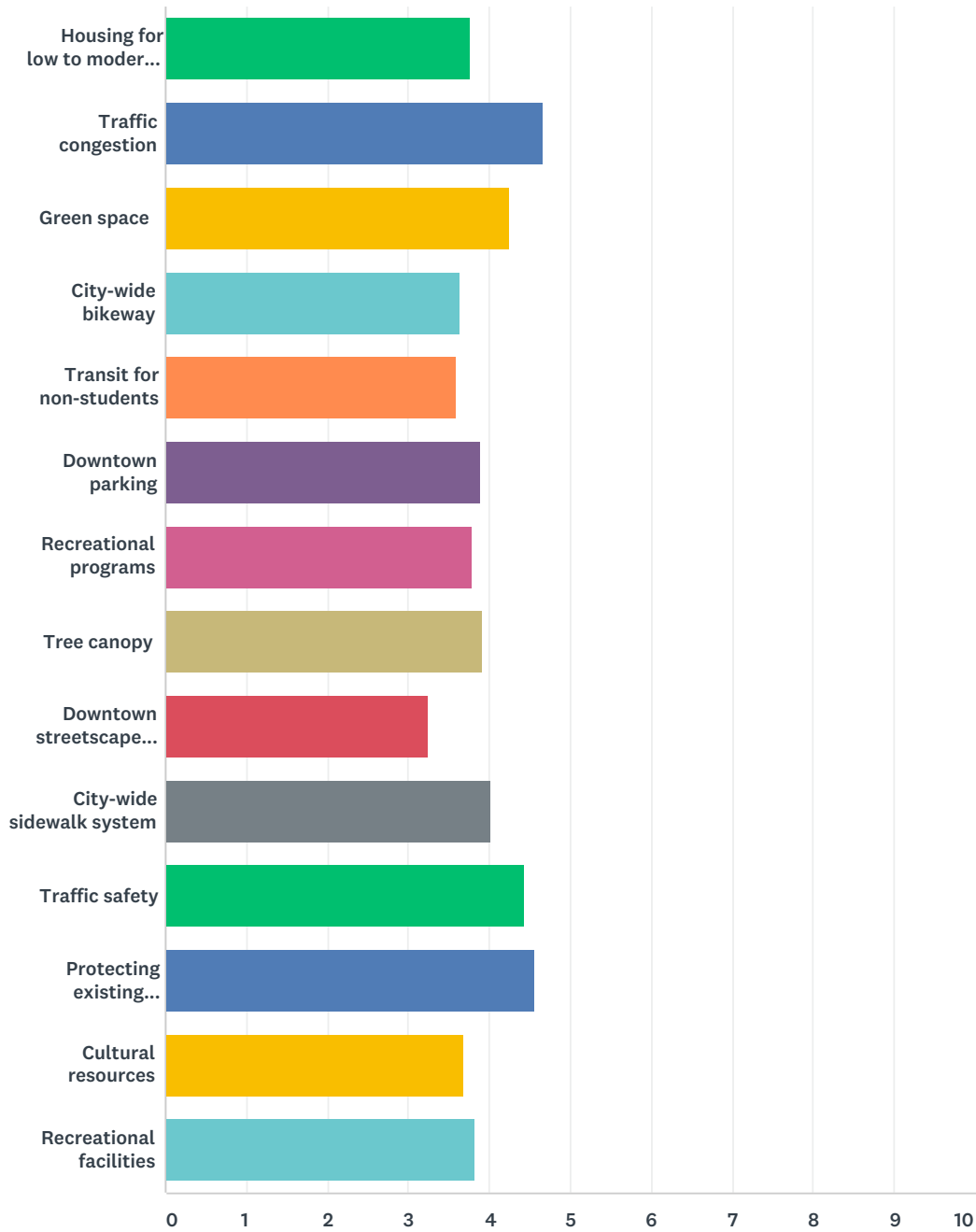

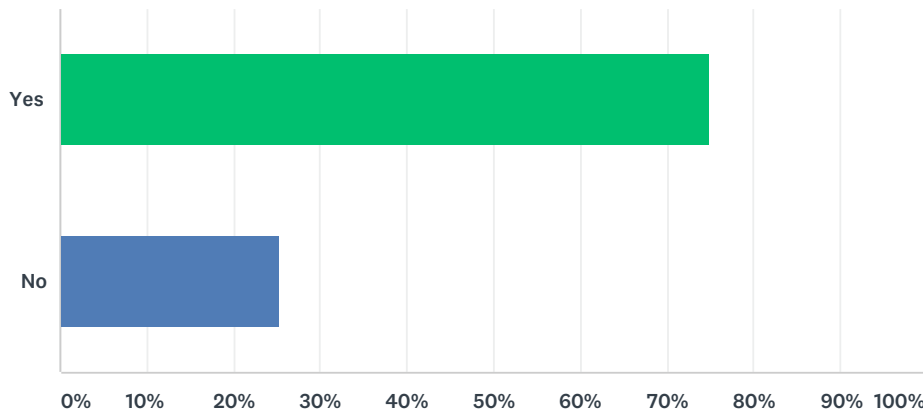

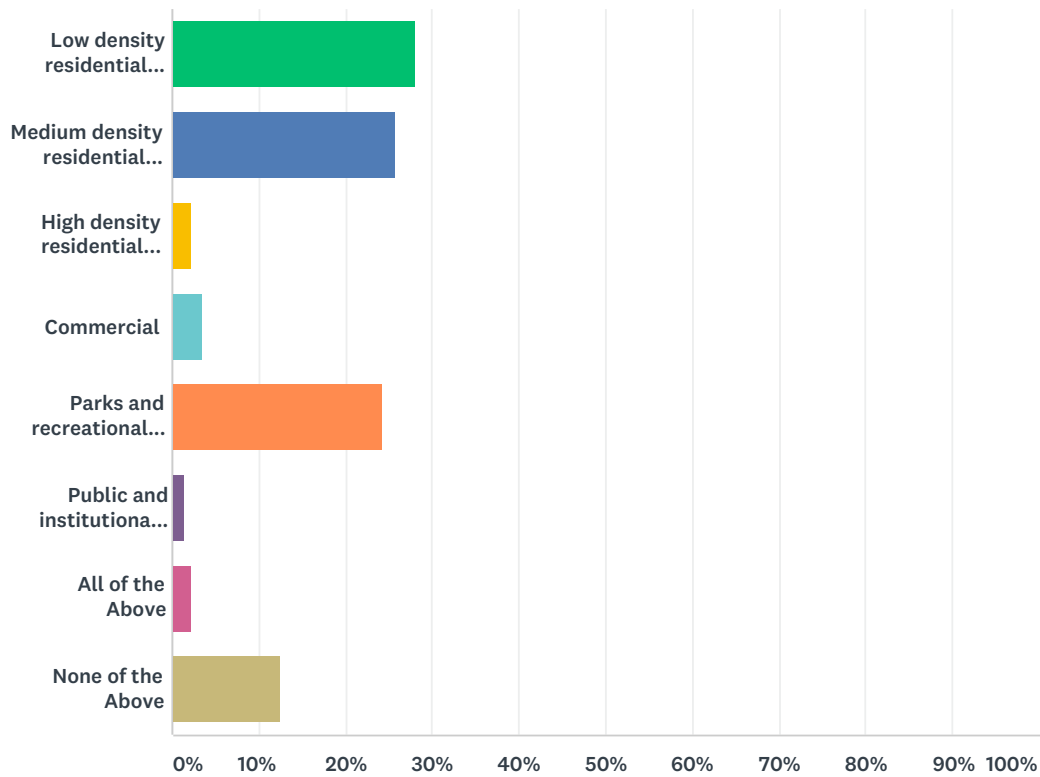

Q4 Of the following land uses, which do you think we have too little of in the City?

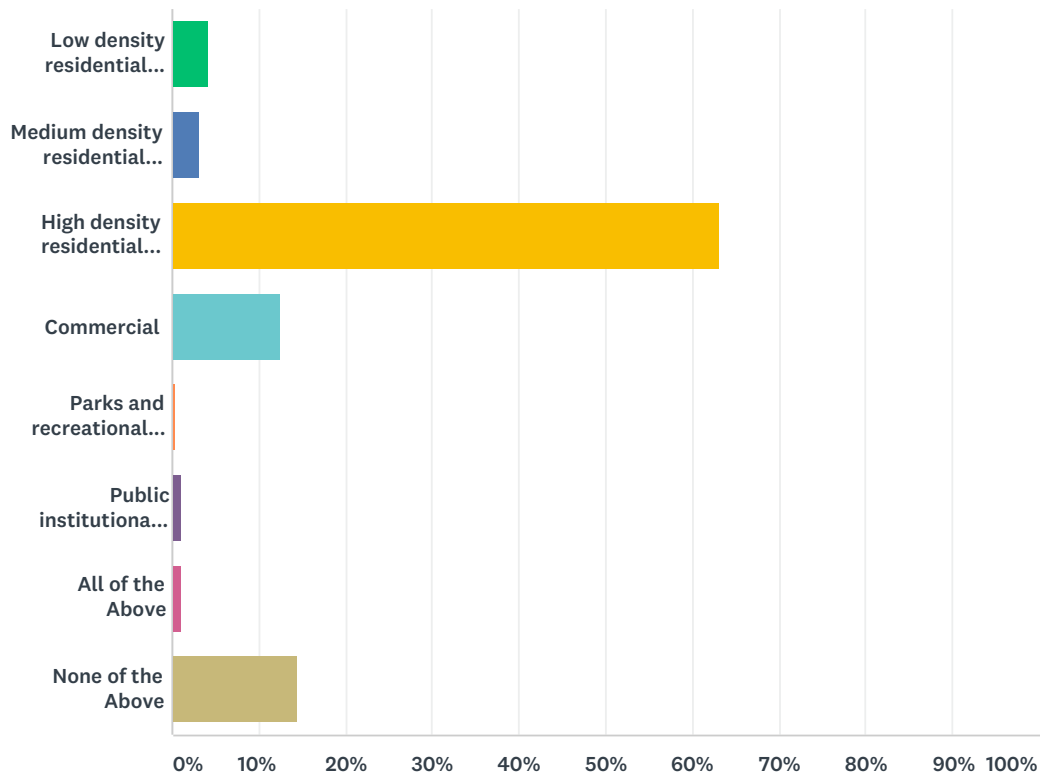

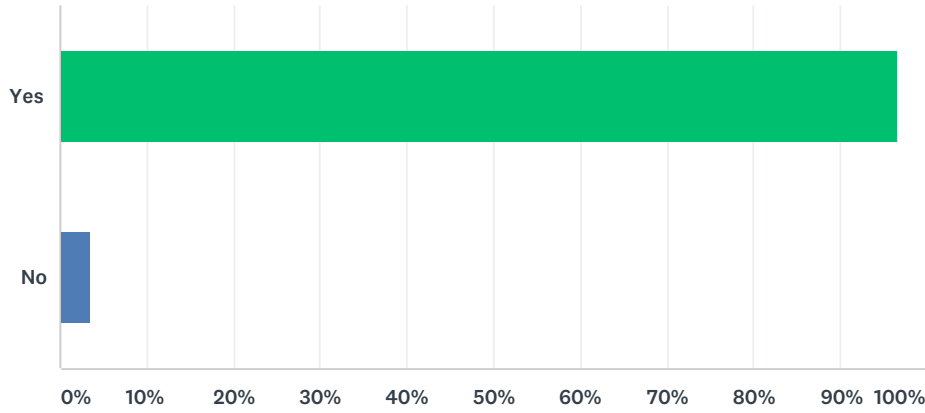

Q6 Do you live within the city limits of Clemson?

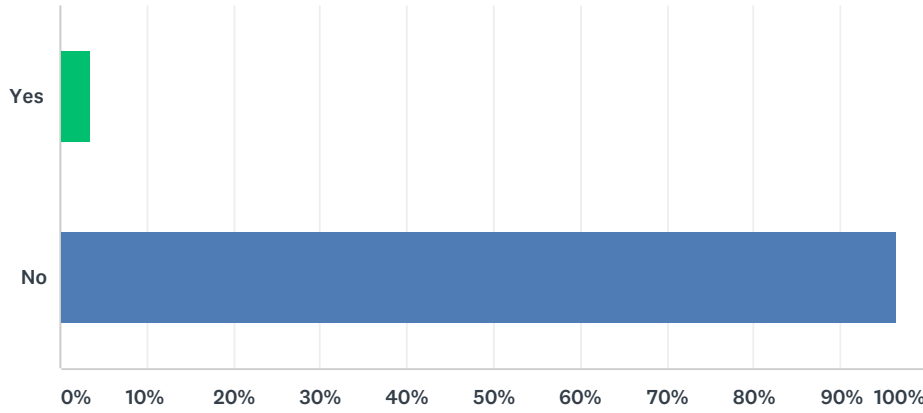

Q7 Are you a full-time college student?

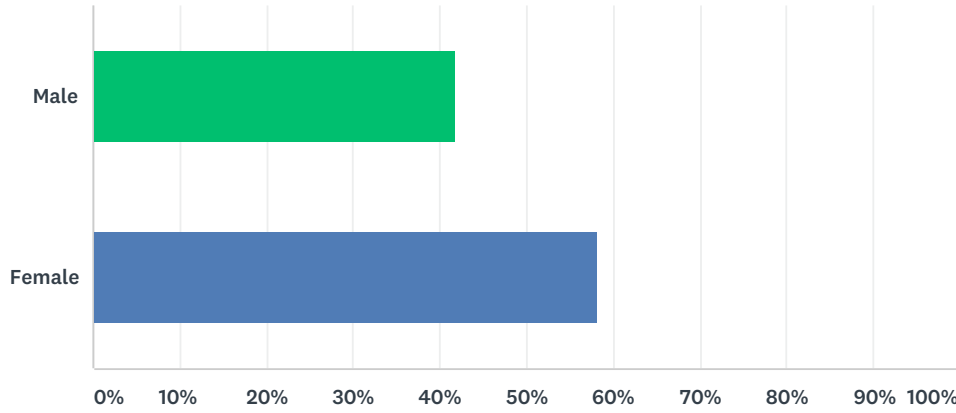

Q8 What is your sex?

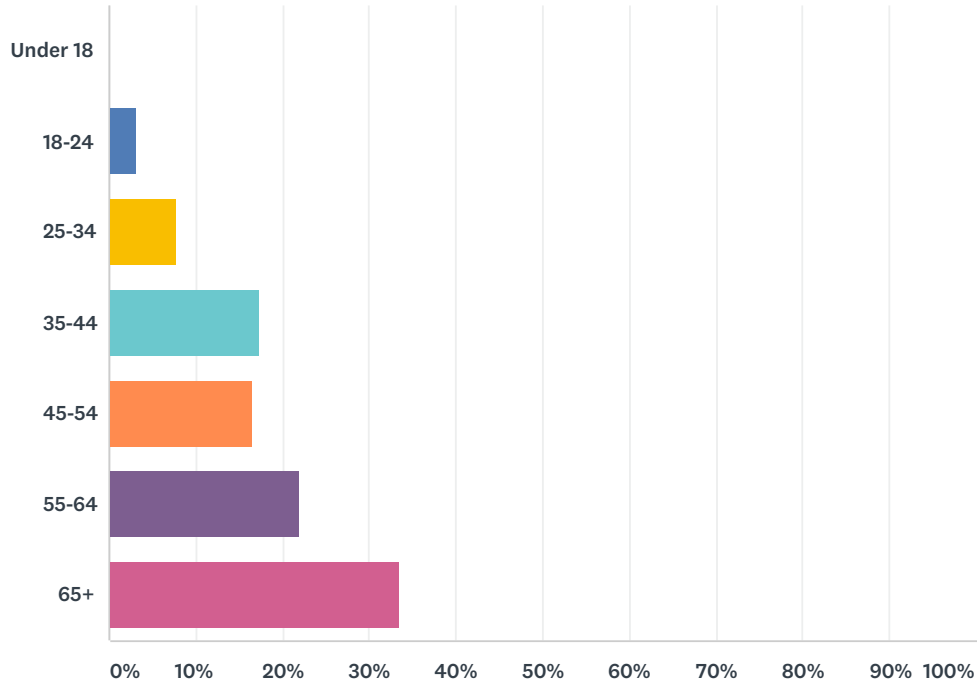

Q9 What is your age?

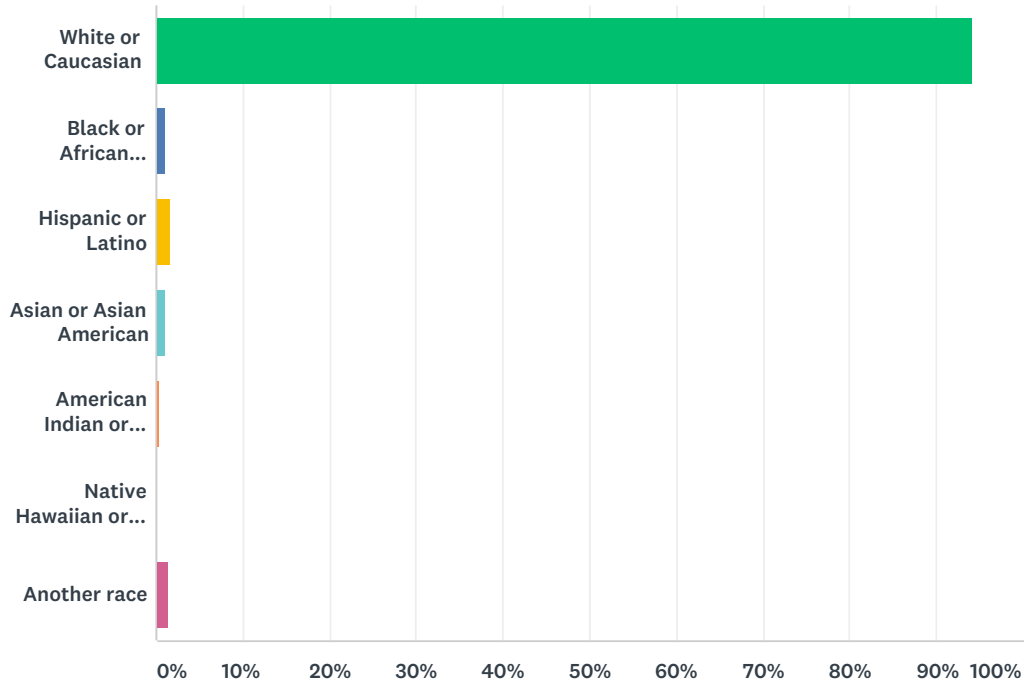

Q10 What is your ethnicity?

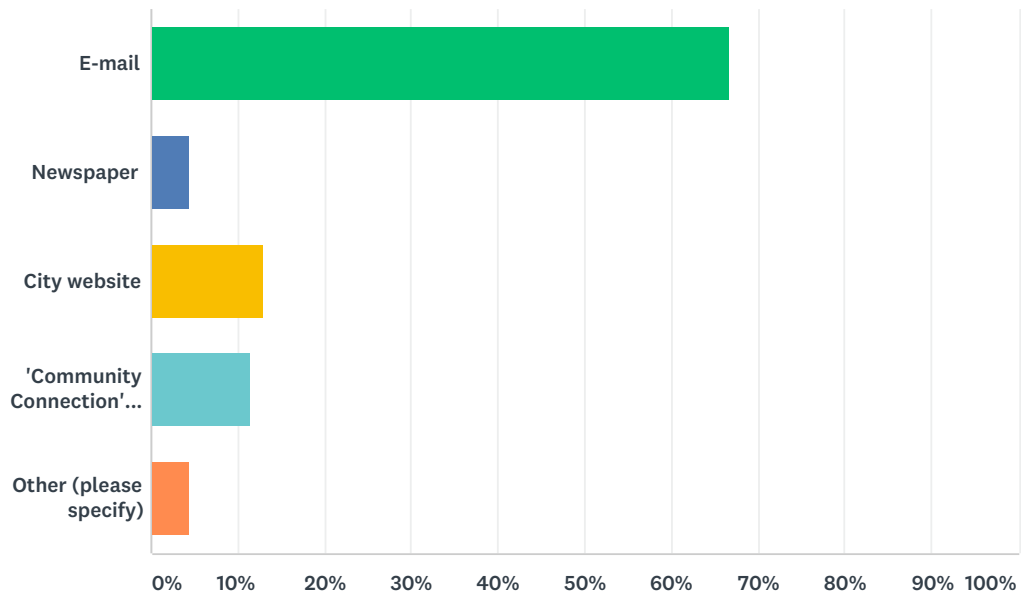
