

CITY OF CLEMSON ORDINANCE CC-2020-27

AN EMERGENCY TEMPORARY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CLEMSON, SOUTH CAROLINA, EXTENDING THE EMERGENCY TEMPORARY FACE COVERING ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, on September 24, 2020, Governor McMaster issued Executive Order #2020-62, extending the State of Emergency in South Carolina and extending a number of prior Executive Orders, including Order #2020-50; and,

WHEREAS, Clemson University continues to conduct testing of Clemson students/faculty/staff; has reported 3180 positive tests from June 5 to September 30, 2020; and has reported having 259 students isolated/quarantined as of September 26, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, testing of the City's wastewater in cooperation with the University continues to show elevated levels of the SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19) virus in all three treatment plants at Concern Level III (as of results available September 30, 2020); and,

WHEREAS, the current emergency temporary face covering ordinance will expire on or about October 23, 2020; and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Clemson, South Carolina, duly assembled and with a legal quorum, as set forth below.

Emergency Temporary Face Covering Ordinance #CC-2020-17, as amended by Council on August 3, 2020, and extended effective August 24, 2020, is hereby extended effective October 23, 2020, for another 60 days.
