

**CITY OF CLEMSON ORDINANCE CC-2020 - 28**

**AN EMERGENCY TEMPORARY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CLEMSON, SOUTH CAROLINA, AMENDING THE PARKING HOURS FOR THE GAME DAY PARKING PROGRAM COVID-19 PROTOCOL.**

**WHEREAS**, it appears that widespread transmission of the COVID-19 virus continues in our City, our State, and the country as a whole; and,

**WHEREAS**, Governor Henry D. McMaster has continued the public health State of Emergency in South Carolina resulting from the pandemic; and,

**WHEREAS**, Clemson University is conducting its fall football season, including home games; and,

**WHEREAS**, after considering the positive manner in which participants in the City's Game Day Parking program have complied with the provisions of the COVID-19 Protocol; and,

**WHEREAS**, having received input regarding reduced patronage of City businesses on game days during the pandemic; and,

**WHEREAS**, after careful consideration, Council wishes to expand the hours for parking in the Game Day Parking program; and,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the City Council of the City of Clemson, South Carolina, duly assembled and with a legal quorum, as set forth below.

1. Council hereby extends the parking hours in the COVID-19 Protocol to permit parking on Clemson football game days by participants in the Game Day Parking program beginning at 7 a.m. and ending at either midnight or 90 minutes after the end of the game, whichever is later.
2. Council urges participants in the program to implement and enforce the Protocol, as well as to take all other legal, common sense measures possible to prevent transmission of the virus, as this may help allow continuation of the program for all of the home football games.

3. Any provisions of the Game Day Parking ordinances (CC Code ##12-203, et seq.) that conflict with the amended provisions of the Game Day Parking program COVID-19 Protocol are hereby suspended.
4. Council will monitor compliance with the Protocol to determine whether the Protocol needs amendment or whether the Game Day Parking program may need to be suspended for public health and safety reasons.
5. This temporary emergency ordinance is effective immediately.
